Construction Zone: Baronial History in Progress...

...By Her Excellency, Baroness Delia Flammen

I took a bit of a break from working on the History project, so I am still working on Part 2: *And So It Begins!* Hopefully I will have that ready for the October Quill. I have made some revisions to Part 1, which was published in the July Quill, after discovering that Master Gavin had already written a memoir about his early years. It can be found on the history page of the Baronial web site. The updated sections are as follows:

Revision 1: How Gavin heard of the SCA

In the Summer of (1974) Dr. Rains first heard of the SCA from an article in a newspaper he picked up while visiting his parents in Louisiana. Intrigued, he wrote a letter to the new King of the Middle Kingdom requesting information, but he never got a reply.

It wasn't until two years later, when he was directing *Macbeth* and needed some swords to use in the production, that a student came to him and told him of a friend in the SCA who could lend them a couple of swords. He was excited to hear about the SCA again and asked for this friend's address. The friend was Baroness Margarethe the Dog of South Downs, in the then Principality of Meridies, Kingdom of Atenveldt. She invited him to his first event, the Red Tower Tourney in South Downs, and gave him a great deal of helpful information and the addresses of others who could help. Over the course of several handwritten letters starting in October of 1976 she graciously answered as many of his questions that she could and sent him a membership form, a somewhat outdated guide to setting up a group and a copy of the "Notus"- her kingdom's unofficial newsletter.

There was no SCA presence in SC when he first started reaching out for information. He had gathered together six or seven Presbyterian College

students who were interested in the Society with the intent of starting a group. Master Gavin saved all his correspondence, and through this we know that he did not have an easy time of finding the information he needed to start a chapter here.

Revision 2: Off to a rocky start, enter Magara di Alessandra and the founding of Tear's Sea Shore and Hidden Mountain

Miraculously, despite having to scrounge for information and communicate through snail mail, the new Shire of Nottingham Hill Coill was off the ground in 1977. The new Shire had a bit of a rocky start. The members decided to attend their first event as a group, and it was a disastrous one. They drove about five hours to get there, but it was freezing cold, nothing happened on time and the people there were not very friendly. They were so discouraged by this that the group drifted apart for a time. Luckily for us, Lord Robin of Mannefeld had heard of their misfortune and invited the whole group to the Tourney of Ymir in Windmaster's Hill. Gavin was unable to convince anyone else from the group to join him, but he went and had a wonderful time and this reignited the passion needed to get the group back together again. At the next event the group went to, Red Tower Tourney, Gavin met Megara di Alessandra, a lady from Charleston, SC. It was her first event and, after talking to Gavin, she was interested in establishing a group in Charleston. She went home to found the Canton of Tear's Sea Shore as a branch of the Shire of Nottingham Hill Coill. As a result of her influence another group established itself in Goose Creek and took the name of the Canton of Hidden Mountain.

Notification of the vote was also sent out on the Baronial e-list. There were no dissenting votes, so the Barony will be purchasing trim for use in Baronial regalia. If you are interested in some trim of your own, please comment on the original FB thread by Calontir Trim on the Baronial FB page, or let me know and I'll do it for you.

The Barony of Nottinghamill Coill recently suffered a loss of one of our own, Lord Jean Claude de Lyon. He leaves behind his wife, Lady Rose, his daughter Lilly, and his parents, Lord Donal and Lady Milicent. Please keep them in your prayers as they navigate this tough time.

Jean Claude received his Award of Arms and became a noble and Lord of the Kingdom of Atlantia in 2008. Thereafter, in 2010 Jean Claude was recognized as a Companion of the Opal for his hard work and service to the Kingdom and Barony. In 2012, Jean Claude's prowess with the rapier blade was recognized when he became a Companion of the Sea Dragon. On the very same day, he became a Companion of the Coill's Champions.

Memories with Jean Claude

"I doubt many people remember that back when Jean Claude was doing rapier, I took him as a personal student. I still remember well the day I knew I had made a good decision. I believe it was the Battle of the Marsh, a day of melees, including, of course, rapier. The task for each side to hold the fort the longest against the other side which had an infinite number of resurrections. In taking the fort, our side did pretty well and then it was our turn in the fort. We fought hard, but we were fairly evenly matched against the other side. I was slain as was most of the team; it was down to just Jean Claude left. He then held off the entire other side for several crucial seconds to win the day.
