

We had a baronial business meeting on the evening of Thursday, April 11th. The next page will include the notes from that meeting.

#### Baronial Business Meeting Notes

On Thursday, Aptil 11th a meeting for the Barony of Nottinghill Coill was called to order. Below are the meeting notes captured.

The meeting started at 7.05pm. There were 14 people present including the Baron & Baroness.

#### 1st item for discussion was approved with no dissenting votes.

1) Change current baronial policies – specifically, change all requirements for announcements from "e-list" to "Barony of Nottinghill Coill social media groups approved for Kingdom use." Currently the baronial requirement is – "The date, time, and place for the Baronial meeting shall be published in the Baronial newsletter and posted on the Baronial e-list at least fourteen (14) days prior to its commencement." The same procedures are required for posting of any baronial office openings.

#### 2nd item for discussion was approved with no dissenting votes.

2) Lease a permanent storage facility with the Barony's boundaries, for storage of the baronial property. Likely locations would be Newberry as a central location to the barony. This proposal is to allow the population to agree and a search to begin.

<u>3rd item for discussion was approved with no dissenting votes. This requires submission by</u> <u>the Baronial Finance Committee to the Kingdom Exchequer for final approval in accordance</u> <u>with Kingdom Financial Policy.</u>

3) Create an office of Quartermaster for the Barony to include responsibilities of inventory, maintenance, repair, and disposal of baronial property. This would create a deputy position under the office of Baronial Exchequer to be responsible for all property under section 11 of the Nottinghill Coill Financial Policy. The Quartermaster is not financially responsible for the repair and replacement with the concurrence of the Exchequer.

#### Baronial Business Meeting Notes

4th item for discussion was approved with no dissenting votes. This requires submission by the Baronial Finance Committee to the Kingdom Exchequer for final approval in accordance with Kingdom Financial Policy.

4) Align reporting requirements for reports to match those of Atlantia. Administrative function but updating policies implemented since Covid to match use of social media for communication. The Kingdom of Atlantia Financial Policy requires that "Autocrats are responsible for filing event reports within 30 days from the date of the event. This applies to both Kingdom and non-Kingdom events." (Section 10) Whereas, baronial requirements are for the Exchequer to file the event report. Therefore, it is recommended we change to reflect this requirement as written by the Kingdom.

5th item for discussion was approved with no dissenting vote.

5) Use of curtain fund to replace current stanchions to an easier system for ground stake reinforcement. The barony maintains a current fund separately for repair and replacement for this reason. This simply allows input from the populace for this expense.

6)Other topics. An additional item discussed was ideas to promote volunteerism in the Barony and possible expansion of some additional positions to the list of compensated event fees. It was decided that Lady Nerewyn and Lord Roderick would develop a survey for the barony to seek input, opinions, and ideas for the larger promotion of volunteering post-Covid era.

The meeting concluded at 7.55 pm, with many offering a second to the motion and all in unanimity.

## Diary of a Crazy Chronicler

#### Change 3.0

As stated in several recent issues of the Quill, it is time for me to step down as the Baronial Chronicler. Being Chronicler has been a wonderful experience and quite fun, but it is time for a new Chronicler to be chosen.

Sometimes people say being Chronicler is hard. Well, I admit it can be challenging to encourage others to submit articles or information for publishing. I understand their concern though. It's something everyone in the Barony is likely to see and that can make people nervous. In the end, the Quill must have certain items that are required to be published by Kingdom and Society so as long as you get those out you are doing an excellent job.

Before putting in a Letter of Intent (LOI) for the Barony of Nottinghill Coill Chronicler position, there are a few questions to ask yourself:

- 1. Do you have the required time to be able to put together the newsletter to meet deadlines? This can sometimes be challenging. I work on the Quill throughout the month about 2 hours per week.
- 2. Do you have the skill set needed? The most important skills for a Chronicler is to be organized, have good time management, and be persuasive. A lot of the content for the Quill comes from other people. You are not required to right an article yourself each month. I do it because I consider it fun. Persuading others to submit articles is a worthy goal.
- 3. Do you have the requisite computer, software, and internet access needed to put together the newsletter? I create the Quill using a basic laptop. I use a free version of Canva to design and publish the newsletter. It's really easy to learn and I'm

happy to help anyone who may be interested. If you are interested in applying for the position, please submit a letter to Their Excellencies and the Baronial Seneschal.
