

I hope to build on my ongoing experiences as a newcomer discovering the traditions and history of a new kingdom and apply it as guide to serving as your Baronial Chatelain.

The Chatelain's office exists to help recruit new members; educate them on the culture and traditions of the SCA; and to encourage and assist the retention of existing members. More practically, local chatelains serve as visible points of contact between newcomers, novices, and established members of the Society. If we want to continue to grow the membership and keep the Society vibrant and evolving, it is not enough to just attract newcomers: We need to help them find the people and activities within the SCA that ignite their creative passions.

The SCA is an organization steeped in diversity, both among its members and among the myriad of arts and activities it encompasses. Our outreach for newcomers and novices must be equally diverse if we want it to be effective. It is not enough to just do public Demos and set up Newcomer & Novices Points at events, we need to be able to guide people in the right directions to pursue their personal interests. If we fail to engage them, they will pursue those interests elsewhere. To this end, over the coming months I will be focusing on, not only building my own personal networks within the Barony but encouraging everyone to help develop an easily accessible network that can potentially benefit both newcomers and seasoned members alike.
